- INSTRUCTIONS:
1. Cut out the template below on the solid line.
 2. Glue or tape it onto the lid of an empty egg carton and start exploring!
 3. Fill the empty egg openings with the corresponding color objects you find outdoors or indoors if needed!

A nature color hunt is a scavenger hunt with a colorful twist! Instead of finding specific objects, you're searching the outdoors for the color spectrum reflected in nature. Some colors will be easy to discover and some will require patient and mindful observation. Look and look again! Happy exploring!



PROJECT VARIATIONS:

1. Mix the color spectrum at home and paint the interior of each egg opening with a color. Colored construction paper works great, too!
2. Turn your color hunt into a photography lesson by using your camera to "collect" your nature discoveries! You can even draw what you find and then color your studies when you get home!
