## BEHAVIOR CODE OF CONDUCT

The Macomb Park District's mission is to provide recreation and park experiences that promote healthy lives, healthy minds and a healthy community. In support of our mission, the District enforces a Behavior Code of Conduct for all individuals participating in or volunteering for a District program or activity, attending a class or event, or using District facilities or property. This code of conduct outlines the minimum expected behavior for all participants and park/facility guest to ensure the safety and comfort of everyone involved.

All participants and park/facility guests are expected to exhibit appropriate behavior at all times. This Behavior Code of Conduct represents the District's overall expectations and aligns with other conduct and behavioral systems within specific programs or services. Participants, parents, volunteers and guests are required to familiarize themselves with this Behavior Code of Conduct, as well as any additional rules and behavior expectations developed for specific programs, events, parks, and facilities as deemed necessary by the Macomb Park District.

The Macomb Park District requires that all participants and park/facility guests comply with the following basic behavior. All participants and park and facility guests shall:

1. Participants and guests must follow program, park/facility rules and comply with direction from District staff.
2. Refrain from using abusive or foul language or employing intimidation tactics.
3. Refrain from threatening or causing bodily harm to self, other participants, guests, volunteers, or staff.
4. Refrain from causing damage to property of others, as well as District assets, such as equipment, supplies, parks and facilities.
5. Not possess weapons.
6. Abide by the rules, regulations and policies of the Macomb Park District.

Failure to adhere to the Macomb Park District Behavior Code of Conduct may result in removal from the program, event, park, or facility.
